A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Tallapoosa Primary School; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Tallapoosa Primary School is providing students with an environment that is
3 conducive to learning and success; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Tallapoosa Primary School teaches the Stranger Danger Program, a 45 minute
5 presentation that teaches children about the dangers of encountering people they do not know
6 and how they should handle such a situation, and is geared to youths from preschool age to
7 the ninth grade; and
- 8 WHEREAS, it is because of this program that seven-year-old Brittney Baxter was educated
9 in the necessary steps to take to avoid becoming the victim of a child abduction; and
- 10 WHEREAS, high expectations for students from faculty, staff, and parents have helped the
11 dedicated students at Tallapoosa Primary School achieve; and
- 12 WHEREAS, by creating a safe, respectful, and nurturing learning environment, Tallapoosa
13 Primary School enables students to learn with confidence, experience success, and achieve
14 their maximum potential; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding work of this fine
16 educational institution be appropriately recognized for contributing knowledge to
17 seven-year-old Brittney Baxter which led to her escape.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 commend Tallapoosa Primary School for the excellent achievements and contributions of the
20 students and staff in making their school superior.
