A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging state and local officers and employees and members of the Georgia National Guard
- 2 and State Defense Force not to assist or cooperate with the armed forces of the United States;
- 3 and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, H.R. 1540 of the 112th Congress, the "National Defense Authorization Act for
- 5 Fiscal Year 2012" which provides for appropriations for the armed forces for Fiscal Year
- 6 2012, provides, in Section 1021, "Nothing in this section shall be construed to affect existing
- 7 law or authorities relating to the detention of United States citizens, lawful resident aliens of
- 8 the United States, or any other persons who are captured or arrested in the United States";
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, the idea of detaining natural born citizens of this country under military
- jurisdiction is repugnant to the citizens of this state.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 13 encourage state and local officers and employees and members of the Georgia National
- 14 Guard and State Defense Force not to assist or cooperate with the armed forces of the United
- 15 States if such aid would, in the opinion of the responsible individual, place any Georgia
- authority in violation of the United States Constitution, the Constitution of Georgia, any
- 17 provision of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, any Act of the General Assembly, or
- any rule, regulation, or ordinance of a state agency or authority, political subdivision, or local
- 19 authority.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 21 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution the public and the press.
