### Senate Bill 518

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend an Act establishing the form of government of DeKalb County and fixing the 2 powers and duties of the officers constituting the governing authority of DeKalb County, 3 approved April 9, 1981 (Ga. L. 1981, p. 4304), as amended, so as to change the description 4 of commissioner districts; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to provide for election 5 and terms of office of subsequent members; to revise provisions relating to amending the Act; to provide for related matters; to provide for submission of this Act for preclearance 6 7 under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to provide for effective dates; to 8 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

#### **SECTION 1.**

An Act establishing the form of government of DeKalb County and fixing the powers and
duties of the officers constituting the governing authority of DeKalb County, approved
April 9, 1981 (Ga. L. 1981, p. 4304), as amended, is amended by revising subsections (b),
(c), and (d) of Section 2 as follows:
"(b) For purposes of electing members of the board of commissioners, DeKalb County is

- divided into seven commissioner districts. One member of the board shall be elected from
   each such district.
- (c)(1) Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 shall be and correspond to those five
  numbered districts described in and attached to and made a part of this Act and further
  identified as 'Plan: dekalbcc-import1-02092012 Plan Type: local Administrator: dekalb
  cc User: bak'.
- (2) When used in such attachment, the term 'VTD' (voting tabulation district) shall mean
  and describe the same geographical boundaries as provided in the report of the Bureau
  of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia.
- 25 (3) The separate numeric designations in a district description which are underneath a
- 26 VTD heading shall mean and describe individual Blocks within a VTD as provided in the

27 report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2010 for the
28 State of Georgia. Any part of DeKalb County which is not included in any such district
29 described in that attachment shall be included within that district contiguous to such part
30 which contains the least population according to the United States decennial census of
31 2010 for the State of Georgia.

(4) Any part of DeKalb County which is described in that attachment as being in a
particular district shall nevertheless not be included within such district if such part is not
contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall instead be included within that
district contiguous to such part which contains the least population according to the
United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia.

37 (5) Except as otherwise provided in the description of any commissioner district,
38 whenever the description of such district refers to a named city, it shall mean the
39 geographical boundaries of that city as shown on the census map for the United States
40 decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia.

41 (6) Paragraphs (2) through (5) of this subsection shall only be applicable with respect to
42 Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

(d)(1) Commissioner Districts 6 and 7 shall be and correspond to those two numbered
districts described in and attached to and made a part of this Act and further identified as
'Plan Name: deksuperdist4 Plan Type: LOCAL User: Gina Administrator:
CNTY-DEKALB'.

47 (2) When used in such attachment, the terms 'Tract' and 'BG' (Block Group) shall mean 48 and describe the same geographical boundaries as provided in the report of the Bureau 49 of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. 50 The separate numeric designations in a Tract description which are underneath a BG 51 heading shall mean and describe individual Blocks within a Block Group as provided in 52 the report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. Any part of DeKalb County which is not included in any such 53 district described in that attachment shall be included within that district contiguous to 54 55 such part which contains the least population according to the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. Any part of DeKalb County which is described 56 in that attachment as being in a particular district shall nevertheless not be included 57 58 within such district if such part is not contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall instead be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains 59 the least population according to the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State 60 61 of Georgia. Except as otherwise provided in the description of any commissioner district, whenever the description of such district refers to a named city, it shall mean the 62 63 geographical boundaries of that city as shown on the census map for the United States

decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. This paragraph shall only be applicable with respect to Commissioner Districts 6 and 7."

## SECTION 2.

67 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 3 as follows:

#### 68 "SECTION 3. (a) Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, as they exist on January 1, 2012, shall 69 70 continue to be designated as Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, respectively, but as 71 newly described under this Act, and such members of the board serving from those former 72 commissioner districts shall be deemed to be serving from and representing their respective 73 districts as newly described under this Act. Commissioner Districts 6 and 7 as they exist 74 on January 1, 2012, shall continue to be designated as Commissioner Districts 6 and 7 as 75 described under this Act and in effect on January 1, 2012. 76 (b) Those members of the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County who are serving as 77 such on January 1, 2012, and any person selected to fill a vacancy in any such office shall 78 continue to serve as such members until the regular expiration of their respective terms of 79 office and until the election and qualification of their respective successors. The successor 80 to each such member shall be elected as provided in this section. 81 (c) The first members for new Commissioner Districts 1, 4, and 5 and the member from 82 Commissioner District 6 shall be elected at the general election on the Tuesday next 83 following the first Monday in November, 2012. Those members of the board elected 84 thereto from new Commissioner Districts 1, 4, and 5 and from Commissioner District 6 in

85 2012 shall take office the first day of January immediately following that election and shall

serve for initial terms of office which expire December 31, 2016, and upon the election and
qualification of their respective successors.

(d) The first members for new Commissioner Districts 2 and 3 and the member from
Commissioner District 7 shall be elected at the general election on the Tuesday next
following the first Monday in November, 2014. Those members of the board elected
thereto from new Commissioner Districts 2 and 3 and from Commissioner District 7 in
2014 shall take office the first day of January immediately following that election and shall
serve for initial terms of office which expire December 31, 2018, and upon the election and
qualification of their respective successors.

(e) Those and all future successors to members of the board whose terms of office are to
expire shall be elected at the time of the state-wide general election immediately preceding
the expiration of such terms, shall take office the first day of January immediately
following that election, and shall serve for terms of office of four years each. Members of

the board shall serve for the terms of office specified therefor in this subsection and until

100 their respective successors are elected and qualified."

- 101 SECTION 3.
- 102 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 23 as follows:
- 103 "SECTION 23. 104 Pursuant to the authority of an amendment to the Constitution ratified at the 1978 general 105 election as set forth in Georgia Laws 1978, pages 2370-2372, which amendment authorized the General Assembly to provide by law for the form of government of DeKalb County and 106 to provide for the various officers, bodies, branches, or agencies by or through which the 107 108 county's governmental powers shall be exercised, any law adopted pursuant to auch authority 109 shall be conditioned on the approval of a majority of the qualified electors of DeKalb County voting at elections held for such purpose when any such law affects the DeKalb County 110 111 government in any one or more of the following ways:
- (1) Changing the number of members, terms of office, or the manner of electing themembers of the governing body of DeKalb County;
- (2) Changing the term of office or the method of electing the chief executive officer ofDeKalb County;
- (3) Establishing the powers and duties of the executive or legislative branch of theDeKalb County government; or
- 118 (4) Changing the powers and duties of the executive or legislative branch of the DeKalb
- 119 County government when such powers and duties have been established by Acts of the
- 120 General Assembly, pursuant to the authority of the amendment to the Constitution ratified
- 121 at the 1978 general election as set forth in Georgia Laws 1978, pages 2370-2372."

## **SECTION 4.**

123 It is the purpose of this Act to reapportion Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 from 124 which members of the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County are to be elected in the November, 2012, general election, as applicable, and in subsequent general elections, and 125 this Act results from changes in population based on the United States decennial census of 126 127 2010. It is not the intention of the General Assembly to affect the membership of current members of the board, their terms of office, or the manner in which their successors shall be 128 elected, and such matters shall remain as provided by law on the effective date of this Act 129 130 until otherwise amended by law, except to the extent of reapportioning the districts represented by such members. 131

132	SECTION 5.
133	The Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act
134	to be submitted for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended;
135	and such submission shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or filed with
136	the appropriate court no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the
137	Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.
138	SECTION 6.
139	This section and Section 3 of this Act and those provisions of this Act necessary for the
140	election of members of the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County in 2012 shall become
141	effective upon the approval of this Act by the Governor or upon its becoming law without
142	such approval. The remaining provisions of this Act shall become effective January 1, 2013.

# **SECTION 7.**

144 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
