- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Arthur Queen was born on April 17, 1942, in Washington, D.C.; and
- 3 WHEREAS, he attended Prince George's Community College and Delaware State University
4 and received a certificate for glass management from Georgetown University; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in March of 1986, Mr. Queen established Ebony Glass and Mirror Company,
6 Inc., now known as EGM Services, Inc.; and
- 7 WHEREAS, after celebrating 25 years in business this past March, he now serves as the
8 chairman where he continues to establish effective customer relations and provides the
9 general public with satisfactory service in the construction industry; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Queen has received numerous public recognitions, including being inducted
11 into the Atlanta Business League's Hall of Fame in 2011 and as a National Association of
12 Minority Contractors Hall of Fame member in 2001, named as one of the Atlanta Business
13 League's Men of Influence, and honored with the Small Business Award by the Greater
14 Atlanta Economic Alliance in 2009 and the Parren Mitchell Award in 2001; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Queen is a member of the 100 Black Men of DeKalb, Georgia Glass

- 20 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Mr. Queen is an active member of Love Life
21 Christian Fellowship Church where he serves as deacon; and

22 WHEREAS, he has been united in love and marriage to Sandra for 30 years; and

24 distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
