- 1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Robert Wittenstein; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Robert Wittenstein has been an involved member of the Dunwoody
3 community for over 20 years, serving as an integral part of the development and
4 incorporation of the City of Dunwoody; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he has served on the Citizens for Dunwoody Executive Board and as a lead
6 member of the Charter Task Force, treasurer, and chairman for the ten task forces created to
7 help shape the future government of Dunwoody; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was elected during Dunwoody's first municipal election on September 16,
9 2008, and served with distinction as one of the first councilors of the City of Dunwoody,
10 bringing his business acumen and detail-oriented perspective to each discussion for the
11 betterment of the community; and

24 Dunwoody and this state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and
25 associates; and

27 this distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
