A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 14, 2012, as Concrete Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, today's value of the Georgia Concrete Industry is \$1 billion; and
- 3 WHEREAS, more than 90 percent of the cement used to make the concrete used in Georgia
4 is made in the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, currently 36,000 Georgians rely on the Concrete Industry directly or indirectly
6 for employment; and
- 7 WHEREAS, every district in the Georgia House and Senate is served by at least one concrete
8 industry facility; and
- 9 WHEREAS, concrete is the most widely consumed substance on earth, apart from water, is
10 one of the world's most energy efficient building materials, and is 100 percent recyclable;
11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, concrete roads allow up to 7 percent greater fuel economy; and
- 13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the Concrete Industry be appropriately
14 recognized.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 recognize March 14, 2012, as Concrete Day at the capitol.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
18 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the public and the press.
