## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 7 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to HOPE scholarships and grants, so as to provide for a scholarship for
- 3 attending out-of-state institutions; to provide for forgiving repayment of such scholarships
- 4 for students who return to this state; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 5 and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 7 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to HOPE scholarships and grants, is amended by revising Code Section 20-3-519.12,
- 10 which is reserved, as follows:
- 11 "<u>20-3-519.12.</u>
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'qualified out-of-state institution' means a
- 13 <u>nonproprietary institution of higher education located in a state other than this state which</u>
- 14 <u>has received accreditation by a national or regional accrediting agency recognized by the</u>
- 15 <u>United States Department of Education.</u>
- 16 (b) Any person who has an unweighted cumulative grade point average of 3.8 or higher
- and who is otherwise eligible for a scholarship under this part shall be eligible to receive
- 18 <u>a scholarship to attend a qualified out-of-state institution. Such person shall be excused</u>
- 19 <u>from repayment of such scholarship if he or she returns to reside in this state on a full-time</u>
- 20 <u>basis on a schedule of \$15,000.00 forgiven for each year of residence, which may be</u>
- 21 <u>calculated on a quarterly basis."</u>

SECTION 2.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
