

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE LOCAL LEGISLATION

Notice is given that there will be introduced at the regular 2012 session of the General Assembly of Georgia a bill to provide a homestead exemption from White County ad valorem taxes for the county purposes in the amount of \$100,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for residents of that county who are 70 years of age or older, to provide for definitions; to specify the terms and conditions of the exemption and the procedures relating thereto; to provide for applicability; to provide for a referendum, effective dates, and automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
