A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and celebrating the 100th birthday of Ms. Lottie Mae Reid Munford; and for other
2 purposes.

4 Georgia, a beloved daughter of Enoch Reid and Nancy Fuller Reid; and

7 in their community; and

10 Baptist Church where she has been a member for 50 years, is the mother of the church,

13 ideals, morals, and deep concern for her fellow citizens and she possesses the vast wisdom

17 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she has made of her life,
