A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Honorable Marvin S. Arrington, Sr., on the occasion of
2 his retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Honorable Marvin S. Arrington, Sr., has long been recognized by the
4 citizens of this state for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal
5 commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he was one of the first African American graduates from the School of Law of
7 Emory University in 1967, received his undergraduate degree from Clark College, and
8 studied as an International Business Fellow at the London School of Business; and

9 WHEREAS, he was first elected to the Atlanta Board of Aldermen in 1969, served as
10 president of the Atlanta City Council from 1981 to 1996, and was senior partner in the law
11 firm of Arrington and Hollowell before being appointed as the Superior Court Judge for
12 Fulton County in 2002; and

13 WHEREAS, an active member in his community, Judge Arrington has been a member of
14 numerous boards, including the Lake Lanier Islands Development Authority, the
15 Metropolitan Atlanta Olympic Authority, the Atlanta Convention and Visitors Bureau, the
16 Advisory Board of the World Trade Club of Atlanta, the Commerce Club, the Atlanta
17 Business League, the Atlanta Lawyers Club, and the Board of Governors of the Atlanta City
18 Club; and

19 WHEREAS, he has been honored numerous times, including as "One of Atlanta's Top 25
20 Lawyers" by *Atlanta* magazine and "Among the 100 Most Influential People in Georgia" by
21 *Georgia Trend* magazine, and has received the Chief Justice Robert Benham Award, the Seth
22 Kirschenbaum Diversity Award, and the Clarence Cooper Legacy Award; and

23 WHEREAS, Judge Arrington's significant organizational and leadership talents, his
24 remarkable patience and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs
25 of the citizens of this state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and
26 associates; and

27 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
28 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

29 WHEREAS, Judge Arrington has served with honor and distinction, and his vision and
30 unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon the occasion of his retirement; and

31 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
32 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
34 commend the Honorable Marvin S. Arrington, Sr., for his efficient, effective, unselfish, and
35 dedicated public service to the State of Georgia, congratulate him upon the grand occasion
36 of his retirement, and extend to him their most sincere best wishes for continued health and
37 happiness.
