8 Bronze recognition on the basis of the high percentage of students meeting and exceeding

11 the 2010-2011 school year, receiving the Platinum Award; and

12 WHEREAS, this award reflects the results of the exemplary endeavors of the school's
13 students, the dedication of their teachers and faculty, and the many contributions of their

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
