A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending the 25th annual law enforcement cookout; and for other
- 2 purposes.

- 3 WHEREAS, the annual law enforcement cookout started with less than 50 in attendance and
- 4 has grown to over 1,800 in the past year; and

- 5 WHEREAS, Wayne Dasher and Long County Sheriff Cecil Nobles began the cookout in
- 6 1987 to thank all law enforcement for the job they do and for putting their lives on the line;
- 7 and

- 8 WHEREAS, the program portion of the evening provides a ready audience for state-wide
- 9 elected officials to extol the excellence of Georgia's law enforcement and first responders and
- 10 to assure enforcement officers to their unchanging support for those who compel obedience
- 11 to Georgia's safety laws; and

- 12 WHEREAS, in recent years, first responders have been added to the honoree list, including
- 13 fire fighters, emergency medical technicians, military personnel, and corrections officers; and

- 14 WHEREAS, Tattnall County Sheriff Quintin Rush, Liberty County Sheriff Don Martin, and
- 15 Wayne County Sheriff John Carter joined in hosting the occasion a few years back; and

- 16 WHEREAS, the event is held in April every year, and Sheriff Craig Nobles, Cecil Nobels's
- 17 son, recently stepped in to host the cookout; and

- 18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the annual law enforcement cookout and
- 19 all local law enforcement officers, on behalf of the citizens of this state, be appropriately
- 20 recognized.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body commend the care, courage, sympathy, and selfless dedication
23 exhibited by law enforcement officers and first responders in carrying out the difficult duties
24 of their vocation, extend to them their utmost appreciation for having so purely and truly
25 defined for others the meaning of public servant, and recognize the 25th annual law
26 enforcement cookout.
