A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Joe Sam Robinson, Jr.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Dr. Joe Sam Robinson, Jr., has long been recognized by the citizens of this state
3 for his leadership in the field of medicine, his compassionate treatment of his patients, and
4 his deep concern for the well-being of others; and

6 WHEREAS, he graduated with honors from Harvard College in 1967 and received a
7 doctorate in medicine from the University of Virginia in 1971, continuing his training with
8 rotations in London, England, an internship and a general surgery residency at Emory
9 University in Atlanta, and a neurosurgical residency at Northwestern University in Chicago;

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Robinson began his neurosurgical practice at the Medical Center of Central
12 Georgia in 1981, became chief of the neurosurgery department in 1988, and is currently
13 chairman of the department of surgery; and

14 WHEREAS, he has completed many teaching assignments, including stints at the University
15 of Illinois, Mercer University, and the Medical College of Georgia, and visiting
16 professorships and lecture dates in Thailand, Scotland, Honduras, Italy, China, Lithuania, and
17 Peru; and

18 WHEREAS, an active member in the community, Dr. Robinson is a former member of the
19 Georgia Trauma Care Network Commission; and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Robinson has contributed numerous articles for publication in noted
21 periodicals, including the *Journal of Chronic Diseases*; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of
23 this distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 commend Dr. Joe Sam Robinson, Jr., for his many years of selfless service in the medical
26 field to the State of Georgia and extend to him their sincere best wishes for continued health,
27 happiness, and success.
