A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Tyler J. Kaplan; and for other purposes.

21 tour guide for the Georgia Tech Office of Admissions, an attorney for the Georgia Tech
22 Mock Trial Team, and a staff writer for Georgia Tech's newspaper, *The Technique*; and

23 WHEREAS, Tyler has shown by the example of his academic accomplishments and
24 extracurricular involvement that the pursuit and attainment of excellence are within the reach
25 of the students in this state; and

26 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks forward with great anticipation to the promising and
27 bright future of this remarkable young citizen.
