- 17 WHEREAS, Timothy chose as his STAR Teacher Gilmer County High School educator Eric
- 18 Tedders, who provided support and guidance throughout the years and encouraged Timothy
- 19 to achieve his utmost potential; and

- 20 WHEREAS, Timothy has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal
- 21 adroitness, and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

22 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this
