A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Capitol Commission and Pastor Ron J. Bigalke; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Capitol Commission is a charitable and religious nonprofit organization of state
4 directors who are pastors and missionaries that teach weekly verse-by-verse Bible studies for
5 the entire capitol community, including the General Assembly and its staff and agencies; and

6 WHEREAS, these state directors also meet personally with many government leaders to
7 proclaim God's grace in salvation, encourage leaders, pray with them, and provide biblical
8 counsel; and

9 WHEREAS, the mission of Capitol Commission is to reach the state capitol communities for
10 Christ one person at a time, disciple them, and prepare them for a lifetime of ministry; and

11 WHEREAS, Capitol Commission is supported by generous gifts from businesses, churches,
12 and individuals; and

13 WHEREAS, Pastor Ron J. Bigalke is a spokesperson with Capitol Commission who spends
14 his time generously driving to the capitol weekly for bible study; and

15 WHEREAS, Pastor Bigalke has demonstrated his commitment to teaching the Gospel,
16 witnessing Christ through word and deed, and addressing the physical, psychological,
17 intellectual, and spiritual needs of others; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message
19 of peace and love be recognized and congratulated for its innumerable good works rendered
20 on behalf of persons in need.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body commend Capitol Commission and Pastor Ron J. Bigalke for their
23 dedicated service to the entire capitol community and extend to them their sincere best
24 wishes for continued health and happiness.
