#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Apostle Sanjay English; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Apostle Sanjay English is a third generation member of the Apostolic Church  
3 and the son of Pastor John and Arnetta English; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he earned a bachelor's degree in psychology and religion from Manhattanville  
5 College and after 12 years of stewardship training was licensed to preach by Apostle Darryl  
6 McCoy and ordained an apostle for Christian Ministry; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he has held professional positions in administrative, supervisory, marketing, and  
8 managerial fields for 30 years and served as assistant pastor of Emmanuel Ministries for 20  
9 years which he and his father organized with seven members in an innercity storefront and  
10 now sits on a 4.5 acre campus; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Apostle English serves the Apostolic Church in numerous capacities, including  
12 administrative assistant and member of the executive committee to the General Assembly  
13 since 1989 and member of the AIM executive staff since 1997; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he has served in the National Adjutancy of the Church of God in Christ, Inc.,  
15 from 2000 to 2005, as assistant general secretary/administration from 2000 to 2002, and as  
16 assistant coordinator/secretary for the constitutional convention and chairman of the AIM  
17 2003 local committee from 2002 to 2003; and
- 18 WHEREAS, after moving to Atlanta, he started the Unity in Faith Ministries in the  
19 gymnasium of John F. Kennedy Middle School in the impoverished South West Atlanta  
20 neighborhood; and

21 WHEREAS, after ten years of walking the streets, ministering to the poor and needy, and the  
22 miraculous growth of the ministry, he expanded Unity in Faith Ministries and was able to  
23 move it into larger worship facilities in 2005; and

24 WHEREAS, he has demonstrated his commitment to teaching the Gospel, witnessing Christ  
25 through word and deed, and addressing the physical, psychological, intellectual, and spiritual  
26 needs of others; and

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message  
28 of peace and love be recognized and congratulated for his innumerable good works rendered  
29 on behalf of persons in need.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
31 the members of this body commend Apostle Sanjay English on his years of service to the  
32 Lord and the State of Georgia and extend best wishes for successful fellowship and  
33 leadership in Unity in Faith Ministries.
