

The House Committee on Judiciary offers the following substitute to HR 1611:

#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the need to preserve the sovereignty of a foreign corporation to engage in  
2 certain commercial activities within the confines of Baldwin County, Georgia; and for other  
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, it is of considerable importance to preserve the sovereignty of a foreign  
5 corporation and to allow such corporation to engage in certain commercial activities within  
6 the confines of Baldwin County, Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, it is of further importance that such foreign corporation have the ability to  
8 contract with Georgia corporations and enter into a joint venture with Water Energy  
9 Technologies Incorporated, Baldwin County, Georgia, the State of Georgia, and others in  
10 accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia; and

11 WHEREAS, it is also imperative that the foreign corporation maintain its foreign corporation  
12 independence and sovereignty while entering into a joint venture with Water Energy  
13 Technologies Incorporated, an Alabama corporation, whereby both organizations may  
14 develop and manufacture green energy fuels; and

15 WHEREAS, the source of such green energy fuels is from a wood chips process developed  
16 by Water Energy Technologies Incorporated; and

17 WHEREAS, these entities may construct other commercial enterprises on property owned  
18 by said joint venture partners at the discretion of the joint venture partners, and may be  
19 approved by the governing body of Baldwin County, Georgia.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 the members of this body recognize the need to preserve the sovereignty of a foreign  
22 corporation to engage in certain commercial activities within the confines of Baldwin  
23 County, Georgia and the State of Georgia, and subject to the laws of the State of Georgia.
