A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act reincorporating the City of Doraville in the County of DeKalb, approved
- 2 October 13, 1971 (Ga. L. 1971, Ex. Sess., p. 2154), as amended, so as to change the
- 3 corporate limits; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 An Act reincorporating the City of Doraville in the County of DeKalb, approved October 13,
- 8 1971 (Ga. L. 1971, Ex. Sess., p. 2154), as amended, is amended by revising the description
- 9 of the corporate limits of the City of Doraville in Appendix A by adding at the end the
- 10 following:
- 11 "In addition to all other territory included within the corporate limits of said city, the
- corporate limits shall specifically include the following described property, all of which is
- located in DeKalb County, Georgia:
- 14 Tract 1:
- All that property contained in the unincorporated island with its boundary between the
- 16 City of Doraville, Georgia, and the City of Dunwoody, Georgia, proceeding along Tilly
- 17 Mill Road from Woodwin Road to across Peachtree Industrial Boulevard to the boundary
- of the City of Dunwoody, Georgia.
- 19 <u>Tract 2:</u>
- All that property contained in the unincorporated island with its boundary between the
- 21 City of Doraville, Georgia; the City of Dunwoody, Georgia; and Gwinnett County,
- Georgia, from the City of Dunwoody, Georgia, City Limits along Peachtree Industrial
- Road until the City of Doraville, Georgia, City Limits beyond Winters Chapel Road,
- bordered on the north by Gwinnett County, Georgia."
