A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Senior Police Officer Eric Antonio Jones on the occasion of
2 his retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Senior Police Officer (SPO) Eric Antonio Jones has long been recognized by
4 the citizens of this state for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep
5 personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by his 30 years of superlative service with the Atlanta Police Department; and

9 WHEREAS, SPO Jones joined the Atlanta Police Department on June 18, 1982, and was
10 sworn in as an officer on January 4, 1983, his 22nd birthday; and

11 WHEREAS, during his time with the Atlanta Police Department he was the first recruit to
12 be assigned to the Police Athletic League, assigned to Chief of Police Office in 1988, and
13 promoted to Senior Police Officer/Field Training Officer in 1993; and

14 WHEREAS, SPO Jones's significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable
15 patience and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the
16 citizens of this state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and
17 associates; and

18 WHEREAS, he has been highly regarded by state and local government officials as a person
19 of unquestioned integrity and dedication to the administration of justice and sound principles
20 of law enforcement; and

21 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
22 intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

23 WHEREAS, SPO Jones has served with honor and distinction with the Atlanta Police
24 Department and his vision and unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon the
25 occasion of his retirement; and

26 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
27 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
29 commend Senior Police Officer Eric Antonio Jones for 30 years of efficient, effective,
30 unselfish, and dedicated public service to the State of Georgia; congratulate him upon the
31 grand occasion of his retirement; and extend to him their most sincere best wishes for
32 continued health and happiness.
