

The Senate State and Local Governmental Operations Committee offered the following substitute to HB 839:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to provide for the election of the members of the Paulding County Board
2 of Education, approved March 21, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2381), as amended, particularly by
3 an Act approved April 25, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 4151), so as to revise the districts for the
4 election of members of the board of education; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to
5 provide for the manner of election; to provide for qualifications; to provide for payment of
6 expense allowance for attendance at meetings; to provide for submission of this Act for
7 preclearance pursuant to Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to
8 provide effective dates and for automatic repeal under certain circumstances; to provide for
9 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

11 An Act to provide for the election of the members of the Paulding County Board of
12 Education, approved March 21, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2381), as amended, particularly by an
13 Act approved April 25, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 4151), is amended by striking Section 1 in its
14 entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Section 1 to read as follows:
15

"SECTION 1.

16 (a) The Board of Education of Paulding County shall be composed of seven members.
17 Any person, in order to be eligible for membership on the board, must be registered and
18 eligible to vote for members of the General Assembly from Paulding County, must have
19 resided in Paulding County for at least one year immediately preceding the date of election,
20 and must reside in the education district from which such person offers as a candidate for
21 at least six months immediately preceding the date of election. The members of the board
22 shall be elected by the qualified electors of the entire county. The at-large member shall
23 be a resident of Paulding County and shall be elected by the qualified voters of the entire
24 county and shall represent District 7 which shall be composed of the entire county.

26 (b) For the purpose of electing the six members of the board from education districts,
 27 Paulding County shall be divided into six education districts. One member of the board
 28 shall be elected from each such district. Those districts shall be and correspond to those
 29 six numbered districts described in and attached to and made a part of this Act and further
 30 identified as 'Plan: pauldsbR-2012 Plan Type: Local Administrator: Paulding SB
 31 User: Gina'.

32 (c)(1) For the purposes of such plan:

33 (A) The term 'VTD' shall mean and describe the same geographical boundaries as
 34 provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial
 35 census of 2010 for the State of Georgia. The separate numeric designations in a district
 36 description which are underneath a VTD heading shall mean and describe individual
 37 Blocks within a VTD as provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the
 38 United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia; and

39 (B) Except as otherwise provided in the description of any district, whenever the
 40 description of any district refers to a named city, it shall mean the geographical
 41 boundaries of that city as shown on the census maps for the United States decennial
 42 census of 2010 for the State of Georgia.

43 (2) Any part of Paulding County which is not included in any district described in
 44 subsection (b) of this section shall be included within that district contiguous to such part
 45 which contains the least population according to the United States decennial census of
 46 2010 for the State of Georgia.

47 (3) Any part of Paulding County which is described in subsection (b) of this section as
 48 being included in a particular district shall nevertheless not be included within such
 49 district if such part is not contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall
 50 instead be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains the least
 51 population according to the United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of
 52 Georgia."

53 SECTION 2.

54 Said Act is further amended by striking Section 2 in its entirety and inserting a new Section 2
 55 to read as follows:

56 "SECTION 2.

57 (a) In the event that any member elected from a district ceases to be a resident of his or her
 58 respective education district during his or her term of office, a vacancy shall be created and
 59 shall be filled in the manner as provided in this Act. All members shall be nominated and

60 elected in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the
61 'Georgia Election Code,' as now or hereafter amended.

62 (b) The members of the board in office on the effective date of this section shall continue
63 in office for the terms to which they were elected and until successors are elected and
64 qualified as provided in this section.

65 (c) The members of the Board of Education of Paulding County from Education Districts
66 2, 5, and 6 shall be elected in the general election in November 2014. Such members shall
67 take office on January 1 following their election for terms of four years and until their
68 successors are elected and qualified.

69 (d) The members of the Board of Education of Paulding County from Education Districts
70 1, 3, and 4 shall be elected in the general election in November 2012. Such members shall
71 take office on January 1 following their election for a term of four years and until their
72 successors are elected and qualified.

73 (e) The member of the Board of Education of Paulding County from Education District
74 7 shall be elected in the general election in November 2012. Such member shall take office
75 on January 1 following his or her election for a term of four years and until his or her
76 successor is elected and qualified.

77 (f) Successors to members elected under subsections (c), (d), and (e) of this section shall
78 be elected at the general election next preceding the expiration of such terms of office and
79 shall take office on January 1 following their election for terms of four years and until their
80 successors are elected and qualified.

81 (g) Education Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 as they exist immediately prior to the effective
82 date of this section shall continue to be designated as Education Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6,
83 and 7, respectively, but as newly described under this Act, and, on and after the effective
84 date of this section, such members of the board serving from former Education Districts
85 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 shall be deemed to be serving from and representing Education
86 Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, respectively, as newly described under this section."

87 **SECTION 3.**

88 The Board of Education of Paulding County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to
89 be submitted for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; and
90 such submission shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or filed with the
91 appropriate court no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the
92 Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.

SECTION 4.

94

If, as of the first date upon which candidates may begin qualifying for the general primary in 2012, implementation of this Act is not permissible under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, then as of such date, this Act shall be void and stand repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 5.

The provisions of this section and Section 2 of this Act, relating to and necessary for the regular election in 2012 of members of the Board of Education of Paulding County, shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval; and this Act shall otherwise become effective January 1, 2013.
