## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Youth Leadership Thomasville-Thomas County on the  
2 occasion of its 15th anniversary; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Youth Leadership Program sponsored by the Thomasville-Thomas County  
4 Chamber of Commerce was established in 1997, and Thomasville-Thomas County was one  
5 of the first cities in Georgia to offer a leadership program for high school juniors; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the program teaches youths to be aware of the needs and problems of the county  
7 and state, to develop leadership skills, and to work together as a team so that they may  
8 resolve some of these needs and will be better prepared as decision makers and become  
9 qualified leaders of this great county and state; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the program reaches out to students in their junior year of high school in the  
11 Thomasville and Thomas County School System; and
- 12 WHEREAS, students are interviewed and selected by the Chamber's Education Committee;  
13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, since the inception of the Youth Leadership Program in 1997, 387 students have  
15 graduated from the program; and
- 16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
17 program be appropriately recognized.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
19 the members of this body commend Youth Leadership Thomasville-Thomas County on its  
20 many contributions to high school students and recognize the program on the occasion of its  
21 15th anniversary.

23 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Youth Leadership
