3 with the passing of Jonathan Samuel Warren Brooks; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Jonathan was born on July 19, 1988, in Marietta, Georgia, a beloved son of
5 John and Tangela Brooks; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a young man of deep and abiding faith, Jonathan was an active member of the
7 Vision for Souls Family Worship Center where he played the drums, participated in Club
8 Vision's youth leadership, and was a member of the former VFS BOYZ; and
- 9 WHEREAS, an athletic young man, Jonathan played for Wallace Park's Little League
10 Association; football for the Powder Springs Cowboys, Mt. Carmel Rams, and South Cobb
11 Eagles; and basketball for Pebblebrook's Youth Association, South Cobb Recreation, and the
12 South Cobb High School freshman team; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he committed a lot of his time to writing and recording music about the
14 goodness of Jesus and his own everyday struggles of the world and using it in a spiritual way
15 to minister; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
17 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
18 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 19 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous young man, Jonathan will long be remembered
20 for his love of family and friendship, and this loyal son, brother, and friend will be missed
21 by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
