### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Joshua Project Worldwide; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the Joshua Project Worldwide is a state-wide coordinated collaborative tour  
3 empowering every Georgian with information and opportunities to make healthy life choices;  
4 and

5 WHEREAS, in partnership with United Healthcare, the Joshua Project Worldwide will create  
6 a state-wide collaborative of stakeholders who share a mutual mission of reaching the  
7 underserved with ministries, products, and services that keep the citizens "livin on top of the  
8 world"; and

9 WHEREAS, the partnership will establish a tour route and a schedule of activities that  
10 engages the target population and exposes them to the opportunities available to facilitate and  
11 implement healthy life choices in a welcoming community environment; and

12 WHEREAS, the Joshua Project Worldwide hopes to utilize events and marketing strategies  
13 designed to specifically reach rural and urban underserved communities and populations to  
14 create an atmosphere of inclusiveness and involvement; and

15 WHEREAS, other collaborative partners with the Joshua Project Worldwide include Georgia  
16 Client's Council, Georgia Department of Community Affairs, Georgia Department of Labor,  
17 Fort Valley State University, University of Georgia County Extension Offices, United States  
18 Department of Agriculture, Albany State University, Savannah State University, the  
19 Legislative Black Caucus, Georgia Association of Black Elected Officials, Georgia  
20 Association of Community Health Centers, Georgia Community Development Association,  
21 ABAC College, the General Missionary Baptist Convention of Georgia, Inc., the Church of  
22 God, Community Action Agencies, and South Georgia District; and

23 WHEREAS, the collaborative will bring together education, media, business, arts and  
24 entertainments, family and health, religion, and governmental authorities and agencies; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
26 project be appropriately recognized.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
28 the members of this body commend the Joshua Project Worldwide for its efforts in reaching  
29 underserved populations with information and opportunities to make healthy life choices.
