A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Christian Aid Mission Partnership; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Christian Aid Mission Partnership (C.A.M.P.) has long been recognized by the
3 citizens of this state for the vital role that the organization has played in providing over 43
4 years of service to Cobb County, Douglas County, and the State of Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, C.A.M.P. is a nonprofit organization that provides food, clothing, and
6 emergency financial aid to Cobb County residents living in Austell, Mableton, Clarkdale, and
7 Power Springs and Douglas County residents living in Lithia Springs; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the services provided by C.A.M.P. primarily exist to combat hunger and
9 homelessness and are provided to economically disadvantaged individuals and families living
10 at 125 percent or below the federal poverty guidelines; and
- 11 WHEREAS, of those benefiting from its services, 47 percent are children under the age of
12 18 and 7 percent are over the age of 55; and
- 13 WHEREAS, C.A.M.P. operates based on the generosity of others, including over 250
14 dedicated volunteers, and is a proud partner agency of the Atlanta Community Food Bank
15 and United Way; and
- 16 WHEREAS, this year marks C.A.M.P.'s 10th annual Spring Chicken Run-A Race Against
17 Hunger, its largest annual fundraising event, originally begun by Macland Presbyterian
18 Church in Powder Springs to benefit the community and subsequently dedicated to
19 C.A.M.P.; and
- 20 WHEREAS, last year, the event hosted 500 participants and raised \$20,000 to address hunger
21 in the communities served by C.A.M.P.; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
23 organization be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body commend Christian Aid Mission Partnership and its 10th annual
26 Spring Chicken Run-A Race Against Hunger for its contributions to end hunger and
27 homelessness in the communities it serves.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
29 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Christian Aid Mission
30 Partnership.
