17 who provided support and guidance throughout the years and encouraged Jesse to achieve
18 his utmost potential; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Jesse has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness,
20 and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and
