15 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
16 becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 17 WHEREAS, his Eagle Project consisted of building a path and stairs over an eroded patch
18 at Vinings United Methodist Church, as well as two seesaws and a bench for the playground;

- 20 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
21 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.
