- 1 Recognizing and commending the Sylvania Information Center upon the occasion of its 50th
- 2 anniversary; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Sylvania Information Center, originally called the Welcome Station, was
- 4 the first welcome center in the State of Georgia and was completed and opened on January

5 20, 1960, on the Wade Plantation off of Highway 301, one of the state's heaviest traveled

- 6 tourist locations; and
- 7 WHEREAS, A.J. Rowan, owner of the Wade Plantation, deeded the land to this state and in
- 8 1972 the State of Georgia purchased 2.03 acres behind the welcome center and constructed
- 9 a water treatment plant to accommodate more traffic; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Sylvania Information Center was the forerunner of ten additional state
- 11 visitor information centers to open between 1963 and 1980 which are located on the

12 interstates bordering Tennessee, Alabama, Florida, and South Carolina, and together they

- 13 make up the 11 Gateways into Georgia; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the Sylvania Information Center is not only the first visitor center built in this
- 15 state but also the oldest operating one in the U.S.; and
- WHEREAS, the image of Georgia has greatly improved and the well-trained personnel of
 the state centers have played a major role in seeing tourism evolve as the second largest
 industry in this state; and
- WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this establishment be appropriatelyrecognized.
