1 Recognizing and commending Mrs. Nannie Mullis Daniels on the grand occasion of her
2 102nd birthday; and for other purposes.

8 where she played an instrumental role in organizing the Special Education Program and also

12 Dodge Retired Educators, PTD President, and member of the Pilot Club and American
