his vision and unyielding commitment is appreciated by the citizens of his community andstate; and

WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of thisremarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL 19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of South Cobb Drive beginning at the 20 intersection of South Cobb Drive and Concord Road to the intersection of South Cobb Drive 21 and Cooper Lake Road is dedicated as the Judge Kenneth O. Nix Highway.
