## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Judge Kenneth O. Nix and dedicating a road in his honor; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Superior Court Judge Kenneth O. Nix was raised in the Grove Park Commons  
4 of Grove Park; and

5 WHEREAS, he graduated from West Fulton High School, and he has been known as a great  
6 athlete over the years; and

7 WHEREAS, he has resided in Cobb County all of his adult life and served in the Georgia  
8 House of Representatives and was later appointed and re-elected to the Cobb County State  
9 Court; and

10 WHEREAS, several years later, Judge Nix was appointed to the Cobb County Superior Court  
11 and was re-elected on several occasions until he retired this past year to spend more time  
12 with his loving wife and family in Smyrna, Georgia; and

13 WHEREAS, Judge Nix has served with honor and distinction with the State of Georgia, and  
14 his vision and unyielding commitment is appreciated by the citizens of his community and  
15 state; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
17 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of South Cobb Drive beginning at the  
20 intersection of South Cobb Drive and Concord Road to the intersection of South Cobb Drive  
21 and Cooper Lake Road is dedicated as the Judge Kenneth O. Nix Highway.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
23 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Judge Kenneth O. Nix  
24 Highway.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
26 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Judge Kenneth O. Nix and to the  
27 Department of Transportation.
