A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 holidays and observances, so as to change the date of Georgia Day; to repeal conflicting
- 3 laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 5 SECTION 1.
- 6 Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to holidays and
- 7 observances, is amended by revising Code Section 1-4-17, relating to observance of "Georgia
- 8 Day," as follows:
- 9 "1-4-17.
- 10 September 25 The twelfth day of February in each year is declared to be 'Georgia Day,' as
- 11 the anniversary of celebrating the landing of the first colonists in Georgia under
- 12 Oglethorpe."
- 13 SECTION 2.
- 14 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
