A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending the Reformed Theological Seminary; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Reformed Theological Seminary (RTS) is one of the largest seminaries in the
- 3 United States, serving the church well by preparing pastors and leaders for more than 46
- 4 years, with 12,000 alumni serving in all 50 states and in more than 70 countries around the
- 5 world; and
- 6 WHEREAS, RTS recognized Atlanta and the State of Georgia as an important global
- 7 crossroads and founded a local campus in 1996; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the Atlanta campus of RTS was housed at The Church of the Apostles between
- 9 1996 and 2010 thanks to the generosity of Dr. Michael Youssef, and has experienced
- 10 tremendous growth and strong financial management under the leadership of its Atlanta
- 11 campus President Mr. John T. Sowell; and
- 12 WHEREAS, RTS made a further commitment and investment in the region with the purchase
- of a 25,000 square foot facility in Marietta in 2010 to serve as a dedicated campus for RTS
- 14 Atlanta and seeks to serve students without uprooting them from family, church, or business
- by offering a flexible, convenient, and accessible graduate theological education; and
- 16 WHEREAS, RTS is a winsome, interdenominational school and maintains relationships with
- 17 a variety of denominations and churches, including more than 20 denominations and many
- more independent congregations, in its effort to become a regional impact center; and
- 19 WHEREAS, RTS Atlanta serves 300 students annually through four fully accredited degree
- 20 programs, with alumni serving today in pulpits of churches in the metropolitan Atlanta area;

- 28 campus ministries, parenting their children, and teaching elementary school; and
- 29 WHEREAS, RTS exists to glorify the Triune God and to serve the church by preparing its
- 30 leaders through a program of graduate theological education based upon the authority of the
- 31 inerrant Word of God and committed to the reformed faith, and it is abundantly fitting and
- 32 proper that RTS be appropriately recognized.
- 33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 34 the members of this body commend Reformed Theological Seminary for its contributions to
- 35 the field of education and extend to them their sincere best wishes for future success.
