3 the citizens of Coweta County on water conservation; and

4 WHEREAS, Coweta County, like many other counties in Georgia, has been experiencing

5 severe drought and record growth, which means additional water consumption; and

6 WHEREAS, a water conservation and education curriculum was designed for Coweta

7 County's fourth grade students, and fourth grade teachers attend Educator's Workshops each

8 year in order to learn the curriculum; and

9 WHEREAS, the curriculum is research based and teaches youths that water is a natural

10 resource that must be respected and conserved, which supplements the current fourth grade

science curriculum and aligns with Georgia Performance Standards for fourth grade science;

WHEREAS, in 2011 middle and high school students and teachers joined the WaterEducation Team and adopted the water conservation curriculum; and

WHEREAS, educators attended a seminar taught by Tara Muenz, the "Adopt a Stream"
coordinator with the Environmental Protection Division (EPD); and

WHEREAS, the "Adopt a Stream" seminar was put together by the WET and is composedof representatives of the Coweta County Water and Sewerage Authority (WASA); and

- WHEREAS, members of the WET are Coweta WASA, Newnan Utilities, Coweta CountyExtension Service, Coweta County storm-water management, the Coweta County School
