A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to distilled
- 2 spirits, so as to authorize free tastings of distilled spirits to be conducted on the premises of
- 3 distillers as a part of educational and promotional distillery tours; to define certain terms; to
- 4 provide for the conditions under which such consumer tastings may be conducted; to provide
- 5 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to distilled spirits,
- 9 is amended by inserting at the end thereof a new article to read as follows:

10 "ARTICLE 8

- 11 3-4-180.
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 13 (1) 'Free tastings' means the provision of complimentary samples of distilled spirits to
- the public for consumption on the premises of a distiller.
- 15 (2) 'Sample' means one-half of one ounce of distilled spirits.
- 16 (b) The commissioner shall, upon proper application therefor, issue an annual permit to
- any distiller licensed in this state authorizing such distiller to conduct educational and
- promotional distillery tours which may include free tastings on the premises by members
- of the public of tax-paid varieties of distilled spirits manufactured by such distiller.
- 20 (c) No distiller conducting free tastings under this Code section shall provide, directly or
- 21 <u>indirectly, more than the one sample to a person in one calendar day. Free tastings shall</u>
- be held in a designated tasting area on the premises of the distiller, and all open bottles
- shall be visible at all times."
