1 Recognizing and commending the 194th Armored Brigade; and for other purposes.

- 13 WHEREAS, the 194th Armored Brigade is the only unit in the Active Army that trains initial
- 14 entry tankers, scouts, and Bradley and Abrams mechanics; and
- WHEREAS, many of the graduating soldiers from the 194th Armored Brigade will report
 straight to units that will deploy to Afghanistan within months for continued combat actions;

- WHEREAS, the selfless and heroic actions of the 194th Armored Brigade and its trainees stand as a shining tribute to the strength of the human spirit, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of these remarkable and distinguished Georgians be appropriately recognized.
