## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. John A. Jackson upon the occasion of his retirement; and

4 the vital role that he has played in the teaching profession and his deep personal commitment  
5 to the education of the students of Georgia; and

7 distinction as evidenced by his 25 years of superlative service, with ten years in Rome City,  
8 three years in Clarke County, five years in Greene County, and seven years in Oconee  
9 County; and

11 Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (ASCD) and former member of  
12 the International ASCD Conference Planning Committee and International ASCD  
13 Constituent Relations Committee; and

15 newsletters and in *The Herald Journal*; and

16 WHEREAS, Dr. Jackson's significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable  
17 patience and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the  
18 citizens of this state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Jackson has served with honor and distinction as an educator and his vision  
21 and unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon the occasion of his retirement; and

22 WHEREAS, in recognition of his contributions to the students in this state, it is abundantly  
23 fitting and proper that the extraordinary commitment and accomplishments of this  
24 outstanding individual be appropriately recognized.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
26 the members of this body commend Dr. John A. Jackson for 25 years of sacrifice, foresight,  
27 accomplishment, and contributions on behalf of education in Georgia and for the positive
