- 16 15.7 percent between 1971 and 2010, and Ms. Archer is living proof of that; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the money collected from the specialty license plate sales is designated for the
- 18 Addario Lung Cancer Medical Institute through the listed recipient, The Joan Gaeta Lung
- 19 Cancer Fund; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Ms. Archer's significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable
- 21 patience and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the
