A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Ms. Jacqueline Archer on her outstanding public service; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Ms. Jacqueline Archer has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for
4 the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by her superlative service as a former Holly Springs city councilwoman and
9 philanthropist; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Archer is asking state legislators to approve a specialty license plate that
11 will not only fund lung cancer research but also spread awareness of the disease; and

12 WHEREAS, she was involved in an accident that required transportation to a hospital and
13 upon further evaluation she learned that her body had been battling Adenocarcinoma, the
14 fastest spreading lung cancer; and

15 WHEREAS, the survival rate for people with lung cancer has gone up from 15.5 percent to
16 15.7 percent between 1971 and 2010, and Ms. Archer is living proof of that; and

17 WHEREAS, the money collected from the specialty license plate sales is designated for the
18 Addario Lung Cancer Medical Institute through the listed recipient, The Joan Gaeta Lung
19 Cancer Fund; and

20 WHEREAS, Ms. Archer's significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable
21 patience and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the

22 citizens of this state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and
23 associates; and

24 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
25 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

26 WHEREAS, Ms. Archer has served with honor and distinction and her vision and unyielding
27 commitment sets the standard for public service; and

28 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
29 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
31 commend Ms. Jacqueline Archer for her efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated public
32 service to lung cancer research and the citizens of the State of Georgia and extend to her their
33 most sincere best wishes for continued health and happiness.
