**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend an Act reincorporating the City of Doraville in the County of DeKalb, approved
2 October 13, 1971 (Ga. L. 1971, Ex. Sess., p. 2154), as amended, so as to change the
3 corporate limits; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act reincorporating the City of Doraville in the County of DeKalb, approved October 13,
8 1971 (Ga. L. 1971, Ex. Sess., p. 2154), as amended, is amended by revising the description
9 of the corporate limits of the City of Doraville in Appendix A by adding at the end the
10 following:

11 "In addition to all other territory included within the corporate limits of said city, the
12 corporate limits shall specifically include the following described property, all of which is
13 located in DeKalb County, Georgia:

14 Tract 1:

15 All that property contained in the unincorporated island with its boundary between the
16 City of Doraville, Georgia, and the City of Dunwoody, Georgia, proceeding along Tilly
17 Mill Road from Woodwin Road to across Peachtree Industrial Boulevard to the boundary
18 of the City of Dunwoody, Georgia.

19 Tract 2:

20 All that property contained in the unincorporated island with its boundary between the
21 City of Doraville, Georgia; the City of Dunwoody, Georgia; and Gwinnett County,
22 Georgia, from the City of Dunwoody, Georgia, City Limits along Peachtree Industrial
23 Road until the City of Doraville, Georgia, City Limits beyond Winters Chapel Road,
24 bordered on the north by Gwinnett County, Georgia."

25 **SECTION 2.**

26 This Act shall become effective on December 31, 2012, at 12:01 A.M.

27 **SECTION 3.**

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
