## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Habersham Christian Learning Center, Inc.; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Habersham Christian Learning Center, Inc., (HCLC) was founded in 1980  
4 and is a nondenominational, nonprofit, community based educational organization that  
5 teaches Christian ethics, morals, and values to high school students during their school day;

7 WHEREAS, HCLC's Christian based curriculum gives students the practical skills needed  
8 to successfully face the pressures and stresses of life and empowers them to make sound  
9 decisions; and

10 WHEREAS, of the 159 counties in Georgia, only ten have released-time programs, and  
11 HCLC is the second program started in the state; and

12 WHEREAS, HCLC has taught over 3,000 students with over half of the students taking two,  
13 three, and four courses at the center; and

14 WHEREAS, HCLC functions with a staff of three and is governed by a volunteer board of  
15 directors and advisors with members from area churches who have a heart for young people  
16 and a strong desire to see them come to faith in Jesus Christ and to grow and mature in that  
17 faith; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
19 distinguished organization be appropriately recognized.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 the members of this body commend the Habersham Christian Learning Center, Inc., for over

22 30 years of effective, efficient, unselfish, and dedicated service on behalf of education and  
23 extend to them their best wishes for future success.
