A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the students of Piedmont Academy's One-Act Play on their
2 2011 Georgia Independent School Association AA State One-Act Play Championship; and
3 for other purposes

4 WHEREAS, Piedmont Academy's One-Act Play took home the Georgia Independent School
5 Association (GISA) AA State One-Act Play Championship for the second consecutive year;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, over 100 students from eight GISA AA schools competed, and Piedmont
8 Academy received three first place rankings, earning a total score of 286 out of 300 points,
9 more than five ranking points higher than the second place play; and

10 WHEREAS, this year's winning production by Piedmont Academy was *Thank You for*
11 *Flushing My Head in the Toilet*, a play about the negative effects of bullying in high school;

13 WHEREAS, Piedmont Academy received three out of the five Outstanding Performance
14 Awards, and three of its supporting actors received an outstanding performance plaque; and

15 WHEREAS, the students handled the intense subject matter with maturity, grace, and
16 sincerity; and

17 WHEREAS, the play was directed by Piedmont Academy faculty member Bobbi Sauls and
18 performed and produced by seniors Amy Anuszczyk, Jakey Dunagan, Davis Kimball, and
19 Samuel McGinnis; juniors Lacy Adamson, Carley Cain, Audrey Cleary, Clare Maloney,
20 Samantha Ramsdell, Lucy Strickland, and Jenna Vella; sophomores Montana Dozier, Gabe
21 Hestad, Jordan Hicks, Emmie Kelly, James Marks, Savannah McGinnis, and Katie
22 Odegaard; freshmen Jacob Bowers, Lena Boyd, Gabriel Courtman, and Abby Hyde; and
23 eighth graders Christopher Cain, Bridgette Phillips, and Matti Smith; and

24 WHEREAS, as this magnificent cast and crew earned its well-deserved reputation for
25 excellence by performing with courage and confidence over months of rehearsing, it is
26 abundantly fitting and proper to call them champions.

28 the members of this body commend the students of Piedmont Academy's One-Act Play for
