## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To revise and restate the law relating to the Bleckley County board of education and school

2	superintendent; to provide for the number of members of the board and the districts from
3	which they are elected; to provide for eligibility, manner of election, and filling of vacancies;
4	to provide for a chairperson and vice chairperson; to provide for reimbursement of expenses;
5	to provide for appointment of the school superintendent; to provide for related matters; to
6	provide for submission of this Act for preclearance under the Voting Rights Act; to provide
7	for effective dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
9	SECTION 1.
10	The purpose of this Act is to revise and restate the law relating to the Bleckley County board
11	of education by virtue of the authority contained in Article VIII, Section V, Paragraph II of
12	the Constitution of Georgia.
13	SECTION 2.
14	(a) At the general election in 2012 and quadrennially thereafter a total of three members of
15	the Bleckley County board of education shall be elected. One member each shall be elected
16	from School Board Districts 1, 2, and 3 for terms of four years. At the general election in
17	2014 and quadrennially thereafter two members of the board of education shall be elected.
18	One member each shall be elected from School Board Districts 4 and 5 for terms of four
19	years. A quorum of the board shall be three members.
20	(b) For the purpose of electing members of the board of education of Bleckley County, the
21	Bleckley County School District is divided into five districts. Such districts shall be and
22	correspond to those five numbered districts described in and attached to and made a part of
23	this Act and further identified as 'Plan: bleckleysb-2012 Plan Type: local Administrator:
24	bleckley User: bak'.

(c)(1) When used in such attachment, the term 'VTD' (voting tabulation district) shall
mean and describe the same geographical boundaries as provided in the report of the
Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of
Georgia.

(2) The separate numeric designations in a district description which are underneath a
VTD heading shall mean and describe individual Blocks within a VTD as provided in the
report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2010 for the
State of Georgia. Any part of the Bleckley County School District which is not included
in any such district described in that attachment shall be included within that district
contiguous to such part which contains the least population according to the United States
decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia.

36 (3) Any part of the Bleckley County School District which is described in that
37 attachment as being in a particular district shall nevertheless not be included within such
38 district if such part is not contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall
39 instead be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains the least
40 population according to the United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of
41 Georgia.

42 (4) Except as otherwise provided in the description of any district, whenever the
43 description of such district refers to a named city, it shall mean the geographical
44 boundaries of that city as shown on the census map for the United States decennial census
45 of 2010 for the State of Georgia.

## **SECTION 3.**

(a) No person shall be a member of the board of education if he or she is ineligible for such
office pursuant to the provisions of Code Sections 20-2-51 or 45-2-1 or any other provision
contained in the O.C.G.A.

(b) In order to be elected as a member of the board from a district, a person must have 50 51 resided in that district for at least six months prior to the date such person qualifies as a 52 candidate for election from such district and must receive a majority of the votes cast for that office in that district only and not at large. Only electors who are residents of that district 53 may vote for a member of the board from that district. At the time of qualifying for election 54 55 as a member of the board from a district, each candidate for such office shall specify the district for which that person is a candidate. A person elected as a member of the board from 56 a district must continue to reside in that district during that person's term of office or that 57 58 office shall thereupon become vacant.

59	SECTION 4.
60	In the event a vacancy occurs in the membership of the board of education for any reason,
61	such vacancy shall be filled as follows:
62	(1) If the vacancy occurs more than 90 days prior to the date of a general election
63	preceding the general election at which a successor would be elected for a new full term
64	of office, then such vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term of office at a special
65	election to be held on the same date as said general election preceding the general
66	election at which a successor would be elected to a new full term of office; and in this
67	case the remaining members of the board of education shall, by majority vote, select a
68	qualified person to fill the vacancy until the person elected at such special election takes
69	office; and
70	(2) If the vacancy does not occur more than 90 days prior to the date of a general election
71	preceding the general election at which a successor would be elected for a new full term
72	of office, then the remaining members of the board of education shall, by majority vote,
73	select a qualified person to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. The individual
74	so selected must meet the residency requirements as specified in subsection (b) of
75	Section 3 of this Act.
76	SECTION 5.
77	Members of the board of education shall be elected in nonpartisan elections as authorized by
70	

Code Section 21-2-139 of the O.C.G.A. 78

79 **SECTION 6.** At the first meeting of the board of education in January of each year, the board shall elect 80 81 a chairperson and a vice chairperson, each of whom shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself. 82

83 **SECTION 7.** Each member of the board of education shall be entitled to reimbursement for actual 84 expenses necessarily incurred in connection with travel outside of the county on official 85 business of the board of education, including, but not limited to, attending training sessions 86 87 or state-wide meetings; provided, however, that such travel is authorized by a majority vote 88 of the members of the board of education prior thereto. All expenses shall be approved and 89 verified prior to reimbursement in such manner as may be specified by the board. Each 90 board member shall be entitled to participate in any school district group insurance plan to 91 the extent authorized in Code Section 20-2-55 of the O.C.G.A.

12 LC 35 2694S 92 SECTION 8. 93 The board shall appoint a superintendent of the Bleckley County School System as provided 94 by Code Section 20-2-101 of the O.C.G.A. The superintendent shall possess the 95 qualifications prescribed by the laws of this state for county school superintendents and shall 96 be compensated in an amount to be determined by the board. The present superintendent 97 shall remain in office until his or her successor is appointed.

99 The Board of Education of Bleckley County which existed on December 31, 2012, is 100 continued in existence but on and after January 1, 2013, shall be constituted as provided in 101 this Act. The Board of Education of Bleckley County so continued and constituted, 102 sometimes referred to in this Act as the "board," shall continue to have the powers, duties, 103 rights, obligations, and liabilities of that board as existed immediately prior to January 1, 104 2013.

106 The Board of Education of Bleckley County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to
107 be submitted for preclearance under Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as
108 amended, no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the Governor
109 or otherwise becomes law without such approval
110 SECTION 11.

111 The provisions of this Act relating to and necessary for the regular election in 2012 of 112 members of the Board of Education of Bleckley County shall become effective upon its 113 approval by the Governor or upon its becoming effective without such approval; and this Act

**SECTION 12.** 

114 shall otherwise become effective January 1, 2013.
