- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Jordan Douglas Queen on November 9, 2011; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Jordan was born on November 5, 1994, in Chattanooga, Tennessee, a beloved
5 son of Jarod and Suzanne Queen and a wonderful brother of Braden Queen; and
- 6 WHEREAS, an active youth, Jordan worked in the Awana's Program, worked in an
7 optometrist's office, and planned to attend college to seek a degree as an optometrist; and
- 8 WHEREAS, a young man of deep and abiding faith, Jordan was an active member of
9 Peavine Baptist Church; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was captain of the Gordon Lee High School wrestling team where he
11 wrestled in the 220 pound weight class and was a preseason fourth ranked 220 pound
12 wrestler in Class Single A; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Jordan was 43rd in his class and maintained a 3.656 GPA and a 92.25 grade
14 point average; and
- 15 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous young man with a huge heart and smile, Jordan
16 will long be remembered for his love of family and friendship, and this loyal son, brother,
17 and friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.

19 join in honoring the life and memory of Jordan Douglas Queen and express their deepest and
20 most sincere regret at his passing.
