Senators Fort of the 39th, Stoner of the 6th, Henson of the 41st, Sims of the 12th and Paris of the 26th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Education and Youth Committee substitute to HB 797 (LC 33 4758S) by*
 2 *inserting after "Section 20-2-164" on line 279 the following:*

3 less an amount equal to the average of the 5 mill share for the lowest five school systems
 4 ranked by assessed valuation per weighted full-time equivalent count, as determined by the
 5 department

6 *By substituting "one-half" for "two-thirds" on lines 296 and 297.*

7 *By replacing line 337 with the following:*

8 and grants, including any reductions due to austerity.

9 *By striking "funding allocations," from line 343.*

10 *By replacing lines 344 and 345 with the following:*

11 Education, state charter schools shall, consistent with department rules and regulations, be
 12 treated as contained within a single, state-wide local education agency. This local
 13 education agency shall be administered by the Department of Education, which shall ensure
 14 that state charter schools receive the support required by this article, including, but not
 15 limited to, establishing procedures to ensure that state charter schools receive the funding
 16 required by Code Section 20-2-2089. This Code section shall not be construed to authorize
 17 a state charter school to receive funding for central administration costs, and the total
 18 funding provided to a state charter school pursuant to this article shall be as determined
 19 pursuant to Code Section 20-2-2089.
