- 8 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Reverend Bryant was an active member of
9 Wahoo Baptist Church; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Reverend Bryant was united in love and marriage to Barbara, and was blessed
11 with three remarkable children, Debra Maxwell, Denise Hosemann, and Steven Bryant, five
12 wonderful grandchildren, Kelly and Doug Adams, William and Tyler Maxwell, and Chase
13 Cosgrove, and an adored great-granddaughter, Maggie Dean Adams; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
15 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
16 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
18 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he
19 made this world a better place in which to live; and

20 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Reverend Bryant will long be remembered
21 for his love of God, family and friendship, and this loyal son, husband, father, grandfather,
22 great-grandfather, and friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
