9 skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 994 and has demonstrated
11 great leadership skills and initiative during his 12 years with the Boy Scouts of America

- 13 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout project, Nathan built five horse mounting blocks along the
14 10.5 miles of horse riding and hiking trails at Garland Mountain in Cherokee County; and
- 15 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Nathan has truly exhibited a commitment to the
16 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
17 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
19 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 commend Nathan Alfonso for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor

22 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious
23 rank of Eagle Scout.
