A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Sequoyah High School physics teams; and for other
2 purposes.

4 were recognized by Toshiba and the National Science Teachers Association for achieving
5 Honorable Mention in the 2012 Toshiba/NSTA ExploraVision Awards program; and

7 science and exploring its impact on technology; and
