A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Clarence Webb on the occasion of his retirement; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Clarence Webb has been highly regarded by the citizens of his community
4 and state and by local government officials as a person of unquestioned integrity and
5 dedication to the sound principles of law enforcement; and

6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by his superlative service with the Cobb County Police Department; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Webb began his law enforcement career in 1990, became an auto theft
10 investigator in 2000, was appointed as a training officer in 2005, promoted to the rank of
11 sergeant in 2007, and retired in 2012; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Webb has received numerous honors, including the Drew Brown Award
17 in 2011; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Webb's significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable
19 patience and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the
20 citizens of this state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and
21 associates; and

22 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
23 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Webb has served with honor and distinction with the Cobb County Police
25 Department and his vision and unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon the
26 occasion of his retirement; and

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the members of this body show their
28 gratitude for the unique and often unheralded contributions of Mr. Webb and all local law
29 enforcement officers on behalf of the citizens of this state.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
31 the members of this body commend the care, courage, sympathy, and selfless dedication
32 exhibited by Mr. Clarence Webb in carrying out the difficult duties of his vocation,
