A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Daniel S. Papp; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Dr. Daniel S. Papp has long been recognized for the vital role that he has played
- 3 in higher education and his deep personal commitment to students; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Dr. Papp is a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of Dartmouth College and earned a
- 5 Ph.D. in international affairs from the University of Miami; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he joined Georgia Tech's faculty in 1973 as an assistant professor of
- 7 international affairs, became director of Georgia Tech's School of Social Sciences from 1980
- 8 to 1990, founding director of Georgia Tech's Sam Nunn School of International Affairs from
- 9 1990 to 1993, an executive assistant to the president of Georgia Tech from 1994 to 1997,
- 10 interim president of Southern Polytechnic State University from 1997 to 1998, senior vice
- chancellor for academics and fiscal affairs of the University System of Georgia from 2000
- 12 to 2006, and is currently president of Kennesaw State University; and
- 13 WHEREAS, under his leadership, KSU has risen in academic stature as it became a
- doctorate-granting institution and launched its first Ph.D. program; and
- 15 WHEREAS, since Dr. Papp became president, KSU also completed its transition to NCAA
- 16 Division I and expanded its infrastructure with the opening of state-of-the-art buildings, such
- 17 as the student dining hall, the 8,300 seat KSU soccer stadium, and the health sciences
- 18 building; and
- 19 WHEREAS, in 1993, he was recognized as Georgia Tech's "Distinguished Professor," the
- 20 first time the honor went to faculty other than an engineer or physical scientist, and has been
- 21 awarded the Army's Outstanding Civilian Service Medal twice; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Papp has authored or edited ten books and has published more than 60

- 23 journal articles and chapters in edited books; and
